LEEDS

LEEDS IS A MAJOR NORTHERN TECHNOLOGY HUB WHICH ATTRACTS THE ATTENTION OF THE GLOBAL TECH COMMUNITY AS A RESULT OF ITS ASSETS; WHICH INCLUDE LEEDS INSTITUTE FOR DATA ANALYTICS (LIDA) AND CONSUMER DATA RESEARCH CENTRE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF LEEDS. LEEDS ALSO HAS A PIONEER NODE OF THE OPEN DATA INSTITUTE AND THE NATIONAL INNOVATION FACILITY FOR ROBOTICS.

SELBY

SELBY HAS SIGNIFICANT ECONOMIC LINKS WITH LEEDS AND YORK, WITH THE MAJORITY OF ITS RESIDENTS COMMUTING TO THE CITIES FOR WORK. SELBY'S PRIORITY AND IDENTIFIED GROWTH SECTORS ARE TO INCREASE THE APPLICATION OF DIGITAL TECHNOLOGIES. THERE IS SCOPE TO ESTABLISH A SPECIALIST CLUSTER OF DIGITAL AND CREATIVE INDUSTRIES TO SUPPORT.



OFFER TO BUSINESSES

- The area has very high performing primary and secondary schools as well as the excellent independent Read School in the village of Drax, near Selby
- Cost of workspace for micro, small and medium-sized enterprises is cheaper than similar options in Leeds or York
- The borough has excellent road and rail connections to Leeds in particular. Planned electrification of the Selby-Leeds line will reduce journey times to 15 minutes by 2020
- Significant opportunity to develop a digital and creative industry cluster and local supply chains with Yorkshire Studios as the anchor

SKILLS

- Selby is a net exporter of labour to other parts of the City Region, predominantly Leeds and York. This is especially prevalent for skilled workers in the finance and creative sectors
- Selby College has an 'outstanding' rating from Ofsted and offers a range of A-level, vocational courses and apprenticeships in support of the District's key sectors including advanced manufacturing, energy and agritech. The college does not currently offer creative/media related courses at scale, but has the capacity to develop this offer in conjunction with plans to grow this sector over the next 3-5 years
- Leeds Beckett University is home to the Northern Film School and also offers a wide range of film, media and production degree courses. The University provides excellent outreach services across the City Region and are a key strategic partner in providing the skills required for the future development of The Yorkshire Studios
- Selby District is ideally located for access to four universities –University of Leeds, Leeds Trinity University, Leeds Beckett University and University of York. All four institutions provide a range of undergraduate and postgraduate degrees relevant to the area's priority and growth sectors
